



## 1. CARNEGIE ART MUSEUM

The museum's "Subtraction = Abstraction" exhibit surveys the work of California artist William Wray, known for his urban landscape, superhero and figurative series. Over time, his work has shifted from realism toward abstraction. Pictured is an oil-on-wood piece called "7."
